Meeting called to order at 4:04

Roll Call – Members Present: Brad Boven, Josh Brugger, Joe Bush, Kim Crozier, Jeff Tloczynski

Absent/Excused – None

Additions/Corrections to the Agenda – None

Approval of June 22, 2026 minutes: Motion by Brugger, second by Crozier. Motion Passed

Treasurer's Report – Joe Bush presented the treasure's report. Motion to accept made by Brugger, second by Crozier, motion passed.

New Business:

- Jeff Tloczynski introduced as newest board member
- Progressive (Jared Laughlin) presented that up to two additional board members may be added; one appointed via the Lloyds Bayou Lake Board and a second could be appointed via one of the local jurisdictions (Spring Lake Township or Spring Lake Village). Either new member would only have voting rights at a meeting in the event that an existing member were absent. Jared to inquire about Spring Lake Township adding another member. Lloyds Bayou Lake Board took no action.
- Progressive (Jared Laughlin) presented an update on his contractual survey of the Lloyds Bayou; noticed and recommended additional areas for treatment.
- Progressive (Jared Laughlin) presented an update on the harvest permit. EGLE has signed off on it but is awaiting approval from the Army Corps of Engineers. Army Corps of Engineers slowly working through their approval process. Discussion about the long turnaround time took place and alternative fall actions to consider in leu of the ability to harvest this fall were presented.

Motion by Brugger, second by Bush to authorize Progressive to facilitate up to \$8,000 of treatment, and up to \$3,000 of harvesting surface area debris post treatment if the harvest permit is approved. Motion carried unanimously.
